The West Virginia School of Osteopathic Medicine (WVSOM) selected Woolpert to build a new facility that serves as the main hub for student activity at the school and fosters a sense of community on campus. The Student Center is a freestanding, 67,000-square-foot, two-story structure that pays homage to the building's important physical location. As the heart of the school, the signature building features an iconic clock tower that anchors the center and serves as a beacon to the surrounding community.

The campus's history as a military boarding school called for special design and placement considerations to honor its unique past. The building sits on the edge of a historic parade ground, so designers sited the building as to frame the edge of the grounds-maintaining a clear view from campus into this distinctive

The building's two levels include food preparation and dining areas, a two-story campus store, technology support spaces, a recreation center, and a conference hall with room for 1,000 seats. The hall is a flexible space that can be sectioned into smaller rooms with foldable walls. The center caters to students by providing space for student government offices, student mailboxes, and open and quiet study
